Buying, Storage & Safety Tips

- · Are there less hazardous alternatives.
- Read labels before buying: "Warning,"
 "Caution," "Safe Cert"- EPA
- Buy only what will be used up right away.
 Disposal of unused product may be difficult.
- Stabilize new gasoline used in seasonal equipment. Monitor your supply for freshness.
- Protect your eyes, lungs & skin.
- Storage. Avid extreme heat, freezing, dampness that can damage contents and/or containers.
- Properly seal containers. Keep out of reach of children.
- · Do not mix chemicals.
- Never pour hazardous chemicals down the drain.

Business Clean Sweep

Any WI business, school, or organization that generates under 220 lbs of hazardous waste in a month and stores less than 2,205 lbs of hazardous waste in a year may be eligible to use Clean Sweep for cost of disposal only.

What should I know?

- NO LATEX Paint or water-based stain
- · Recycle motor oil & antifreeze/engine coolant
- No fuel oil/heating oil call a dealer
- No empty pesticide jugs. See back page
- No plain fertilizer. Use on plants or place in trash

Accepted Materials:

- DDT; silvex; heptachlor; dieldrin; lindane; toxaphene; and 2,4,5-T
- Mercury thermostats, switches, dimmers. Leave devices intact.
- Lead paint
- Herbicides, insecticides, fungicides, and rodenticides, 'weed & feed' fertilizers.
- Acids & strong bases
- Solvents (acetone, mineral spirits, more)
- All metallic paint
- Liquid oil-based paints, varnishes, lacquers, stains (solvent clean up)
- Photographic chemicals
- Lye
- Pool & spa chemicals
- Wood or paint stripper (methyl chloride, more)
- Wood treatments (penta, creosote, arsenic)
- Driveway sealers
- Antifreeze (engine coolant)
- Farm chemicals
- Old gasoline, diesel, and oil/gas mixes
- Motor oil, contaminated only
- Hydraulic fluids
- Lighter fluid, charcoal lighter, kerosene
- Broken fluorescent bulbs-packed airtight
- Unknown chemicals less than 50 lbs or 5 gallons.
- Lighting ballasts (PCB)

Clean Sweep cannot accept:

High pressure cylinders, propane cylinders, freon gases, infectious & biological wastes, sharps, explosives (detonators, blasting caps, ammunition), radioactive chemicals/devices

Latex paint & water-based stain:

(water clean- up)-make solid. Stir in one part kitty litter to one part paint. If not solid in a week, add more absorbent. 24 hr hardeners available at hardware stores. When solid, put open containers in trash.
