

**RESOLUTION NO. 2025-05**

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE VILLAGE OF CLINTON, WI**

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Clinton, Wisconsin, recognizes the need to establish and update a fee schedule to recover costs incurred by the Village for various services provided to the public; and

WHEREAS, such fees are necessary to ensure that services are provided efficiently and equitably while maintaining fiscal responsibility;


